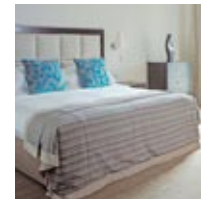

Directions

From the M1: Leave the M1 at Junction 26, taking the A610 towards Nottingham – staying in the right hand lane. At the roundabout, take the last turning off: the A6002 (Woodhouse Way) to Stapleford/Strelley. At the next roundabout, when you see the hotel on your right, take the last exit into Mellor's Way.

From Nottingham city centre: From the ring road, join the A610 (to M1 north/Eastwood/Ripley). Continue until half a mile from Junction 26 of the M1. At the roundabout, take the second turning: the A6002 (Woodhouse Way) to Stapleford/Strelley. At the next roundabout, when you see the hotel on your right, take the last exit into Mellor's Way.

Beeston Fields Golf Club is close to the city centre and the M1, yet tucked away from the bustle of everyday life, Beeston Fields is a relaxing, calm oasis. The Par 71, 6,430 yard 18 hole course offers a challenge for golfers at all levels of skill and experience.

Directions:

From Nottingham: Leave Nottingham by A52 signposted Derby, passing the Queens Medical Centre and Nottingham University on your left. Continue over the next island on to dual carriageway. After approximately 500 yards, turn left at the traffic lights by the Nurseryman pub on to Wollaton Road. Continue up the hill and we are at the top on the right hand side.

From M1: Leave M1 at junction 25 and follow signs for A52 Nottingham. Continue over the first traffic island and through the next intersection. After about one mile take the first turning on the right at the traffic lights at the Nurseryman pub signposted Beeston. Continue up the hill and we are at the top on the right hand side.

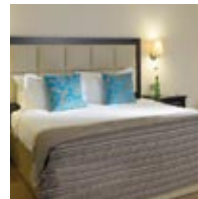
Cancellations and Refunds
